

Streets in CBC Zones

Zone 1

- Western boundary is Pike Dr. and includes the Piedra Hills neighborhood
- Highway 160 is the Southern boundary. All roads north of 160 east to 1st Street are included. This includes Lewis St. and streets crossing it.
- CR 411 (Cemetery Rd.) and roads branching off of it
- CR 400 (Four Mile Rd.) and roads branching off of it including Sonlight Dr. The zone ends 1/2 mile north of Sonlight Dr.
- CR 200 (Snowball Rd which is the same as 2nd St.) north to Four Mile Ranch (the Hershey Ranch). This includes the Elk Run Estates neighborhood.

Zone 2

- Western boundary is Trujillo Rd. south to the transfer station.
- The neighborhoods east and north of Trujillo (which turns east and changes its name to Apache St.) to 84 are included. The high school, elementary school, hot springs, and downtown neighborhoods south of Highway 160 are in this zone. So is Reservoir Hill if it's accessible. Both sides of the San Juan River, the parks along the San Juan, the wetlands, and the waste treatment facility.
- County Rd. 119 (Hot Springs Blvd. which turns into Light Plant Rd.) to Highway 84.
- Highway 160 east out of town to just past the crossing over the San Juan River (near High Country Lodge?). Log Park area, CR 113. The zone ends at the Forest Service gate, which will most likely be closed.

Zone 3

- Highway 84 from its northern junction with Highway 160 south to the south side of Echo Canyon Reservoir. All the roads that branch off from 84.
- County Road 302 (Mill Creek Rd. which turns into Forest Service Rd. 662) to Forest Service Rd. 665 (if the gates are open). Forest Service Rd. 722 will be closed.
- Neighborhoods of Highway 84 include Tierra Del Oro (Tierra Del Oro Dr.), Holiday Acres (Holiday Dr.), Continental Estates (Easy St.), Echo Lake Estates (River Forest Dr.), Blue Lake Estates, Piedra Pines (Pineview Rd.), and Terry Robinson Rd. are included.

Zone 4

- Highway 84 from south of Echo Canyon Reservoir. (The reservoir and shores are part of zone 3.) to County Road 339.
- The private neighborhood of Echo Canyon Ranch (Echo Canyon Ranch Rd.)
- Loma Linda development (Eight Mile Mesa Rd.).
- Forest Service Road 651 (Eight Mile Rd.) is part of this zone but probably has a closed FS gate.
- FS Rd. 651, Rio Blanco Valley.
- County Rd. 326 (Rio Blanco Rd.) to just past Rio Blanco Dr.
- Catchpole Rd.
- Squaw Valley and branching roads.

Zone 5

- Trujillo Rd., starting at the Transfer Station south to 1/4 mile south of FS Rd. 649 (Burns Canyon).
- Do not turn west onto Bristlecone or Cascade (these are part of zone 6).
- Part of the road overlooks the San Juan River at a distance.
- This zone includes the landfill.
- It includes FS Rd 649 (Burns Canyon Rd.) and FS roads which branch off of it. FS gates may be closed to entry.

Zone 6

- The northern zone boundary is Highway 160.
- The western boundary is Hollow Dr. in Aspen Springs (reached by turning south on Oakridge Dr., then turning east. Oakridge itself is not part of the zone.
- CR 139, Springs Estates area.
- All roads in the Pagosa Meadows development. Roads which branch south of Highway 160 are Hersch Ave., Dichoso St., Scenic Ave., Meadows Dr., South Pagosa Blvd. Eastern boundary is CR 500.
- All streets in the Timber Ridge development.
- All roads in Pagosa Alpha.
- The Rockridge area.
- Aspen Village

Zone 7

- The southern zone boundary is Highway 160.
- The western boundary is Ironwood Dr., the entry to Elk Park Meadows and Elk Park Ranch
- Hawthorn Dr., the entry to Martinez Canyon Estates.
- Chris Mountain Dr., entry to Chris Mountain Ranch.
- Trails Blvd. and streets branching off of it.
- Vista Dr. and streets branching off of it.
- Vista Lake, Forest Lake, Village Lake, Pinon Lake, Lake Pagosa
- Streets bordered by Piedra Rd. on the east and Monument Dr. on the north.

Zone 8

- Hatcher Lake
- Stevens Reservoir
- North Pagosa Blvd. and streets branching off of it between Sweet Water Drive on the south and Hatcher Circle (north end).
- Saturn Drive and streets branching from it. Check map for details as the northern circle boundary runs through this area.
- Piedra Road and streets to the east of it between Highway 160 and Incline Circle including Piedra Estates and Cloman Blvd.
- Streets to the west of Piedra Road north of Dutton Creek.
